ACTIVE PARTICIPANT APPLICATION PACK

Over a period of five-months, this once in a lifetime educational experience will bring 5 percussion and 5 composition students, 12 to 23 years of age, together with professional musicians in a series of collaborative developments, lectures, workshops, lessons and rehearsals culminating in a performance.

Applications are now open for this outstanding opportunity.

written application requirements

All applicants are required to submit the following written application material:

- **Completed application form** (found below)
- **Biography** (1 page in length)
- **Letter of recommendation** (from a teacher, mentor, or professional)
- **Statement of intention** (1 page in length)

Statement should articulate what you intend to gain from the program and why you are suited to it.

Percussionists should discuss how the program will affect their practice as a musician and how it will assist in their professional development.

Composers should consider their current musical language and practice as a composer, and how involvement in the program will assist in their compositional development and assist in achieving their professional aspirations. Composers should also be aware that some instrumentation limitations may be placed on any new work generated during the program, and all works will be for percussion quartet.

Notification of acceptance to the program will be announced the week of the 11th of October, 2010.

NB: Applicants for the Emerging Artists Program who are unsuccessful will be automatically considered for the passive participation stream of the program, pending formal enrolment. Passive participants are invited to take observe all rehearsals in a non-performance and take part in group discussions.
